ACADEMIC MEDICINE

CONSTRUCTION OF THE HOSPITAL AND ITS HANDOVER TO THE STATE AUTHORITIES

When the legal agreements expired, the hospital was **handed over to the state in 2020**. In addition to the **HIV and tuberculosis outpatient clinic**, the hospital is now of great importance for **acute emergency care** and for **mothers giving birth**. We continue to support women with free **mother-child packages**.



POLYCLINIC WITH A FOCUS ON PREVENTATIVE MEDICINE, NATURAL HEALING AND PHYSIOTHERAPY

As part of our new **preventative medicine clinic**, we combine **conventional medical care** and diagnostics with naturopathic therapies. The preventative medicine clinic consists of a **laboratory**, an ultrasound, **gynecological and ophthalmological unit**, a wound care unit and a dentist's **unit**.

We treat people not only from the immediate vicinity, but also from remote areas. The **medical education** and **training seminars** which we operate at the clinic, in schools and out in the village communities, create health awareness among people of all ages.

CENTER FOR NATUROPATHY

NATUROPATHY AND PERMACULTURE

After an initial diagnosis and treatment based on conventional medicine, African herbal medicine, homeopathy, vital field therapy, Scenar, acupuncture, medical massages, as well as specially prepared mixtures and remedies find their equal standing in the naturopathic clinic. If necessary, therapeutichealing interventions can be re-applied to address deeper causes of the disease. Patients who are being treated for pain also receive support and help by way of physiotherapy.

This **broad-based**, **integrated approach to healing** is widely accepted by the local population.

We source **local medicinal plants** from our **permaculture-project** for the treatment of our patients and generate awareness of **pesticide-free food cultivation**.


EDUCATION

OUR VISION

Children and young people are given the **tools** to **shape their own lives** through the transfer of knowledge and the acquisition of practical skills.

OUR MISSION

Establishment and maintenance of **English speaking Primary Schools** as well as a **Secondary School** for children from poor families. In these schools, in addition to the students **acquiring knowledge, creativity and independent thinking**, we aim to raise them to become **responsible members of their communities**. A **Vocational Tourism Secondary School** and our other **vocational schools** teach adolescents a trade in order to integrate them into a **stable working environment** as early as possible.

EDUCATION



PRIMARY SCHOOLS

For many years, Africa Amini Alama has been **offering high-quality, Englishlanguage schooling** for **underprivileged children and adolescents** who would otherwise never have had a chance to attend school. They are the **beacons of hope for their families**. We help with education and serve meals on a regular basis. The meal they get at school is often their only meal of the day.

OUR PRIMARY SCHOOLS:

- **Maasai Vision** in Ngabobo, with approx. **309 children**, was our first school in the Maasai region and, with the large number of girls who successfully attend school, is changing the position of women within Maasai families.
- Worseg Vision in Momella, with approx. **350 children**, begins with creative Montessori schooling from the earliest preschool years a foundation for independent thinking.
- **Simba Vision** in Madebe, with approx. **301 children**, is the most remote of our schools. For many Maasai families, from the poorest backgrounds, it is the only option to escape the poverty spiral.

Support for state schools, which, thanks to AAA, can be run as English-language schools:

- Lendoya Primary School, where we not only provide school buildings, but also teachers, school books and school meals.
- **Otlepez Primary School**, where the parents decided to use the income they receive as a village from our Maasai Lodge to maintain the school.
- **Mukuru Primary School**, where we help with food supply, because here, the basic necessities are lacking.
- **Nasula Kindergarten** class, where we help to create an environment of safety and creativity for young children before they start school.

VOCATIONAL SCHOOLS

At our vocational schools, we run **training courses** for bricklayers, carpenters, welders and mechanics who even have their own EP-Garage. Young people from socially disadvantaged families benefit from a **2-year manual training course** here.

There is also a **Tailoring workshop** with an independent production facility, in which young people complete a **2-year tailoring apprenticeship** with an official qualification. The women's sewing group runs the workshop **as its own profit center.**

The **Computer school** with 10 workstations, is where primary and secondary school children, as well as adults from the local community, can acquire basic IT skills in a **three-month course.**





The **Pamoja Secondary School** offers a **high-quality education** to more than **240 secondary school students** and, in the future, also to around **160 High School students**. As a state school, it is run hand in hand with AAA and the parents, operating as a **,School of Excellence**⁴.

The **Africa Amini - Tourism Secondary School**, the first vocational secondary school with a **focus on sustainable tourism**, provides children from the poorest backgrounds with **special skills in the field of tourism**, in addition to the school curriculum. With their post graduate certificate which they receive after 4 years' schooling, they have the best possible chance of being immediately **integrated into the job market**.

KINDERVILLA IN MOMELLA

A home, in which around 42 children experience a **heartfelt sense of togetherness, safety and joy**, whilst also learning valuable **social skills**. In addition to a solid school education, we emphasize that our children grow up in a **loving and creative environment**.

EMERCENCY AID FOR FAMILIES IN NEED

Bridging help is given to families in extremely difficult situations by providing them with assistance packages. This can be one off help or last over several months. It also includes the **construction of houses** from local building materials for single women with children who do not have housing of their own.



SOCIAL



We support **Maasai women's craft groups** in Madebe, Ngabaobo and Lekurumuni. Women who live on the poverty line are able to sell their **jewellery at fair prices** and use the proceeds to buy **food for their children**.

With our help, a group of women at a **sewing workshop** in Momella learned to sew and built a communal production facility. They are now financially independent and **train other girls**.

We also offer **support** to carefully selected women and their **business ideas**, in order to enable them to **live and thrive with their children** thanks to the income generated.
